GEORGE PETER KROYER

LCDR George Peter Kroyer, USN, died of cancer on 19 April 1974 at the Naval Regional Medical Center, Oakland, CA. Memorial services were held in the NAS Lemoore Chapel, followed by burial at sea. A native of Walworth, WI, LCDR Kroyer was a 1960 graduate of the Naval Academy who had made his career in aviation. On completion of flight training in 1961 he was assigned to VA-152, with service in Vietnam where he trained South Vietnamese to fly the A-l. Subsequent tours were at the PG School, Monterey, in Advanced Training Squadron 22 and in Attack Squadrons 122, 56 and 125. His last duty assignment was Operations Officer of VA-93.

His decorations include the Air Medal with numerals 23, Navy Commendation Medal with two stars and Combat "V", Meritorious Unit Commendation and the Vietnam Cross of Gallantry with Silver Star. LCDR Kroyer is survived by his wife, Dana of Lemoore, CA, two sons, his mother and a brother.
