Gilbert T. Mariano died 6 August 1995 at home in Pittsburgh Pennsylvania, of a heart attack. Born 4 May 1937 in Hummelstown, PA, Tom entered the Naval Academy with the Class of 1960 following a year of preparatory school at Wyoming Seminary in Wilkes Barre.PA.
