"Joe" Peek passed away surrounded by his loving family in Decatur, GA, on 16 December 2016 after a short illness.

Born in Ray, AZ, on 28 May 1935, Joe graduated from Tucson High School in 1953 and attended the University of Arizona, where he was in Navy ROTC. His Eagle Scout background served him well. He was appointed to the U.S. Naval Academy and graduated with the Class of 1960. After receiving his Wings of Gold at New Iberia, LA, he flew Grumman S2 Trackers in the VS program for six years, including tours on WASP.

Upon leaving the Navy, he joined Eastern Airlines, where he rose to

Airbus A320 captain. With the untimely demise of Eastern in 1989, Joe was forced to give up flying.

He then reinvented himself several times becoming a locksmith, an information technologist and a Spanish teacher.
