Robert A. Ulrich, 67, formerly of Mayville, died on Saturday, Sept. 27, 2003, at the Clearview Nursing Home, Juneau.

A memorial service took place at the Koepsell Funeral Home, in Mayville, Vicar James Mallmann officiated. Inurnment was in Oak Hill Cemetery, Horicon. Graveside military rites were conducted by the Mayville American Legion Post 69.
