Larry D. Thomas of Concord, NH, passed away unexpectedly at his home on April 1, 2020. Larry was born on October 4, 1937 in Clinton, Indiana, son of Dr. Robert Frank Thomas and Drussa Louise Harrigan. Larry was a graduate of the United States Naval Academy at Annapolis and the United States Defense Intelligence School.

Upon being honorably discharged from the US Navy as a Lieutenant Commander, Larry joined the Concord Police Department, then joined the Merrimack County Sheriff's Department as Chief Deputy.

Larry retired from law enforcement after 25 years and then established his own private investigative firm.
