Lloyd Gordon Rogers, 72, of Corinth, Miss., passed away Monday, May 31, 2010, from complications of surgery. Gordon died peacefully with his daughters by his side. He was born Dec. 6, 1937, to Fred and Vera Rogers.

Gordon was a resident of Waxahachie for more than 30 years. He was a member of Master Gardeners, the Optimist Club and was a member of First United Methodist Church.
